During term we run a series of meetings on Sundays, as follows:

AAW All Age Worship

An informal service of worship and teaching for everyone.

HC Holy Communion

A celebration using liturgy, hymns and songs.

MP Morning Prayer

Worship and teaching focussed on the Bible.

EP Evening Praise

A flexible and relaxed time of worship and teaching.

Deeper— an opportunity to worship with word, song, sight, sound and prayer.

Early Morning Prayer & Open House

Early Morning Prayer in church on Wednesdays from 7.30-8.30am
Please come and go as time permits.

Open house takes place on Wednesdays from 9.30am-12.30pm and is an opportunity to meet others in a variety of ways through listening, chatting & praying. Tea, coffee and snacks are available.

Church Lunches

Church lunches usually take place twice a month after the morning service.

Small Groups at St Silas

These vary in size, emphasis and the frequency of their meetings. What they *do* have in common is that they provide an opportunity for members to feel part of a smaller unit: to share, learn, have fun, eat drink and socialise, to be accountable, to support and encourage one another, to study the Bible and pray together, to tease out what being a disciple of Jesus means in day-to-day life. Activities for children and young people

Youth Cell Group is for 16s and over, meeting weekly at various times/venues. For info. contact Lorraine Darlow.

Youth Fellowship is the group for younger teens. It meets at various times, but most often from 5pm before the Sunday evening service in the Purple Room/Hall. This is a time for building relationships with each other and with God, and is a safe place to ask questions and explore a wide variety of issues. For info, contact Isobel Ross (357 5441).

Powerhouse happens during Sunday morning services and is open to all children aged 0-14. For info. contact Anne McGregor (334 2618).

Powerhouse 4 is an opportunity for young teens to read the bible and ask real questions about what it means to follow Jesus.

Powerhouse 3 allows older children to explore the Bible, helping them to grow in faith through a variety of activities, such as games, crafts, role-playing and music.

Powerhouse 1 & 2 includes crèche for babies. It enables babies, toddlers and pre-schoolers to enjoy fun together and learn about Jesus through creative play, music, song, prayer and stories.

Parent & Baby Area to the rear of the church offers a child-friendly space with baby changing facilities, comfy chairs for parents and lots of toys to entertain non-mobile babies or toddlers.
