Small Groups for Children and Young People

Our vision for small groups extends to every age group within the church family and so there are various ways that children and young people can be 'connected up' on Sundays and during the week. This includes our **Youth Cell Group** (for over 16s), **Youth Fellowship** (for younger teens) and **Powerhouse** (for children aged 0-14 years).

Powerhouse takes place on Sunday mornings and includes baby and toddler groups for youngest members. Baby and toddler groups are available from 11am and run throughout the morning service. Our **Parent & Baby Area** is situated at the rear of the church and offers a child-friendly space with baby changing facilities, comfy chairs and soft toys to facilitate non-mobile babies. Parents are free to spend time with babies in this area during services or events.
