Powerhouse includes supervised baby, toddler and pre-school groups for our youngest members, located in the church hall.

Our **Parent & Baby Area** is situated opposite the ladies toilet and has suitable facilities for feeding and changing babies, as well as space and toys to facilitate non-mobile babies.
