Who are the speakers?

Our speakers will be John and Olive Drane. John teaches practical theology in the Divinity School at the University of Aberdeen and at Fuller Seminary, Pasadena. He and Olive (who has a clown ministry) have three children. John and Olive have a world-wide Christian ministry in churches of many different traditions. His most recent books are "The McDonaldization of the Church" and the groundbreaking evangelistic book addressed to New Agers, "Beyond Prediction: the Tarot and your Spirituality."

Where and what is Lendrick Muir?



Lendrick Muir, in the Ochil Hills, near Kinross, is the Victorian former home of the Moubray family, and now belongs to Scripture Union Scotland. The house is set in extensive grounds with sports facilities. There are several lounges, table tennis and pool tables, a conference room large enough for communal meetings, a sports hall, and a number of outside pitches for football, and much more.

What about sleeping and food?

The accommodation comprises 2- to 7-bedded rooms in the main house and dormitories in the newer unit, Glendevon. Only one or two rooms are available as single rooms. Bedlinen is provided. There are 2 cots available (but no cot linen).

Arrival is from 5pm on Friday and we leave early on Sunday afternoon. All meals on Saturday and Sunday are included in the price. **This year**, there is an extra charge of £6 (free for under 4s) for the **Friday evening meal** (at 7pm). Please remember to book this if you require it.

Food will be cooked for us, but we will have to clear and set tables, wash up and clean rooms at the end of the weekend. There are 3 high chairs, but please bring your own if possible.
